This is to report that the Council on Accreditation of Parks, Recreation, Tourism, and Related Professions (COAPRT), at its meeting on October 4 in St. Louis, Missouri approved continuing accreditation of the University of Tennessee - Knoxville Recreation and Sport Management Program until 2023.

Your institution's accreditation by the COAPRT is valid until the program's next review in the fall of 2023. Prior to the fall of 2023 the program will submit an updated self-study for review by Council. If deemed in accordance with COAPRT Accreditation Standards, the program can expect an accreditation visit between the months of September 2022 and February 2023.
